When?

Mon, May 6th - Sat, May 11th, 2019 with no fees!

Where?

Pratt County Landfill (620) 672-4125

Location: From Pratt: 1 ½ miles south from Lake Rd. on Hwy 281. Turn left at the Waste Disposal Sign, ½ mile east on dirt road. Drive onto scales and the scale attendant will greet you.

Who?

Residents that live within the City of Pratt

Required items:

Provide a Valid ID or City Utility Bill with address currently residing within the City Of Pratt.

All vehicles are required to come across the scales!

Segregation of materials is mandatory! All Metal, Brush, Mattresses, Tires, Concrete and Asphalt items will be separated at the Landfill. (Tires must be 20" or less in size!)

No household chemicals or paint will be accepted at the Landfill.

Hazardous Household Waste:

All household chemicals will be accepted at the Pratt County Recycle Center **only** at 1102 S. Main Pratt, Kansas. If you have any questions please feel free to call us (620)672-4107

Recyclables will be accepted at the Recycling center.

Special pickups:

City of Pratt Residents are encouraged to take advantage of this week to haul their items to County landfill at no charge. The City of Pratt will be organizing special pickups only for Individuals who are not able to haul items to the County Landfill. Please call the City of Pratt @ (620)672-3866. Volunteers and various Organizations will be sent out to assist those that qualify for assistance. Businesses, Contractors and Commercial items are not included with these pickups. Please have items available at curbside to be picked up prior to Monday, May 7th.
